General

Fishing is permitted for <u>MEMBERS ONLY</u>. Exercise caution when crossing the golf course and stay alert during golf hours. Fish are not allowed to be removed from the pond – catch and release only.

Smoking is not allowed in any area of the clubhouse or by the entrance of any door.

Members introducing new visitors to the Club should be responsible for their conduct in the Clubhouse and on the Club grounds, and for all debts due to the Club which may be incurred by them.

CLUB RULES

**All members are responsible to abide by and actively support these rules to assure a safe and enjoyable experience for all members. Any member's failure to abide by these rules is subject to being suspended or lose their membership. **

Membership

MEMBERS

- 1. Any person having been duly accepted as a member of the Mount Airy Country Club as a Member shall be qualified to exercise the rights of membership.
- Having qualified as a golfing member and upon payment of all dues for golf membership, such member shall be entitled to all privileges of golf and house membership and shall be entitled to use all club facilities including, but not limited to, golf course, clubhouse, and swimming pool
- 3. Members of the household of a golf member including spouse and dependent children are entitled to all privileges of membership of a golf member, subject only to such other rules and regulations as shall govern the participation of dependent children during their use of the golf course, swimming pool, and clubhouse.
- 4. All members who have been suspended for non-payment of dues or suspended for any other reason shall <u>not</u> be entitled to use of any club facilities. During the period of any such suspension, neither shall any other of his household members be entitled to use club facilities. After a 90 day suspension of any member, the Board of Directors will determine whether such member is permanently suspended or the avenues for such member's reinstatement.
- 5. Violation of any golf course or other club rule by a member's guest, as herein after defined, or any member of his household will be considered as a violation of such rule by the member.
- 6. Definition: A dependent child, for purposes of these rules, is defined as a natural or adopted child under twenty-five (25) years of age, living in the same household as the member. A married dependent is not entitled to parents' membership privileges. The Board of Directors retain the right to allow exceptions for special needs on a case by case basis.
- 7. Offensive/aggressive behavior or loud or inappropriate language will not be tolerated. Failure to comply may result in suspension of club privileges up to and including lossof membership.

GUESTS

- All members are responsible for reporting guests and seeing that all fees are paid in advance.
 It is not the staff's responsibility to identify and charge members for guests. Failure to report
 guests before will result in a \$25 service fee. Continued failure to report may result in loss of
 membership rights.
- 2. A golfing guest is defined as any person who is not a golfing member and who is accompanied by a golfing member.
- 3. A golf member is entitled to allow his guest to use any part of the club facilities while accompanied by such member.

- 4. Each member is responsible for the behavior of his guest (s), whether on the golf course or while using the club facility.
- 5. Guests living within a twenty-five mile radius of Mount Airy are deemed in-town guests. Those living outside this twenty-five mile radius are deemed out-of-town guests.

Golf/Course Rules

- 1. The rules of golf as promulgated by the U.S. Golf Association shall govern golf play at the Mount Airy Country Club, subject to the following local rules:
- 2. Out of bounds areas are set forth on score cards available to the members and are subject to modification from time to time by the Golf Pro with the approval of the Greens Committee Chairman. Out of bounds areas are marked with white stakes.
- 3. Winter rules permitting ball to be moved with club head in fairway of hole being played shall apply unless announcement is made to contrary for a particular tournament.
- 4. All bare areas in fairways or near cart paths in fairway or near greens will be treated as ground under repair. Golfers may drop ball one club length from such area no closer to hole.
- 5. No one under sixteen (16) years of age shall be allowed to play golf on, Saturday, Sunday or holidays between the hours of 10:00 am and 2:00 p.m. unless they are playing with at least one of his parents. This rule may be modified for tournament or special event play.
- 6. No children under twelve (12) years of age will be allowed to play golf without a parentor adult. Children twelve (12) to sixteen (16) may play at the discretion of the Pro.
- 7. During the winter months (non-growing season) "Winter Cart Rules" will be put into effect at the discretion of the Greens Committee, Superintendent, or Golf Professionaland will be as follows:
- 8. The 90 degree is in effect at ALL times. All carts will remain on paths and only allowed onto fairways at 90 degree paths to the ball position and should return along the same path. Roughs are not considered cart paths and should be treated as fairways. No carts should be within 50' of the greens and all roped off areas and No Carts signed should be observed.
- 9. Under certain conditions and at the discretion of the Greens Committee, Course Superintendent, or the Golf Professional, the course may be deemed unplayable and thus "Closed" until conditions improve.
- 10. In the event of wet conditions "Cart Paths Only" conditions may be implemented as necessary.

Additional Local Rules:

- 1. Ball in other fairways or rough will be played as rough.
- 2. Golfers will repair their ball marks on greens and will replace fairways divots.
- 3. Carts shall not be driven into forbidden areas which are so designated.
- 4. Minimal hitting to or practice putting is permitted on the fairways and greens, multiple shots into greens are prohibited. Short distance chipping, but no pitching, is allowed on the practice green.
- 5. After playing out of sand traps, golfers shall rake the traps smooth.
- 6. The usual rules of golf course courtesy shall be adhered to. Any time as entire hole is open in front of a foursome or fivesome, such group should allow a faster group to play through.
- 7. Golf members may invite guests to play on a green fee basis. Golf member guests may play one day per month on weekends, unlimited times on weekdays. Special events may preclude this privilege.
- 8. The Ladies Golf Association is permitted to invite guests on play days with no green fees. Board of Director approval is needed prior to scheduling of the event.
- 9. Mount Airy Ministerial Association ministers' members may play golf without paying a green fee on weekdays only. They may not play on weekends or Holidays.
- 10. Members may practice in the bottom anytime, provided they do not disrupt golf play. Common sense should be used practicing. Hit balls to the left rough on #6 fairway. No practice will be allowed during any tournament.
- 11. A free drop will be allowed from a paved cart path only.
- 12. All play will begin on the first tee except on tournament days and at the Pro's discretion.
- 13. Only one ball may be hit off the first tee. No mulligans.
- 14. Carts are not permitted to the right of #1, or #9 tees. Must use paved cart path.
- 15. Groups finishing #9 green will alternate with new groups beginning play #16.
- 16. Golf Course Dress Code
 - a. Shirts must have sleeves and collars (including mock turtlenecks) and must be worn at all times. (No tank tops, mid shirts, etc.) Women may wear sleeveless shirts with collars.
 - b. Shorts must be of walking short length-about mid thigh. (No gym shorts, running shorts, swim trunks, sweat pants, or gym pants.)
 - c. Appropriate golf shoes must be worn at all times.
 - d. No jeans or jean shorts may be worn.
- 17. Offensive/aggressive behavior or loud or inappropriate language will not be tolerated. Failure to comply may result in suspension of club privileges up to and including loss of membership.

MACC PRIVATE GOLF CART RULES

- 1. Carts are to remain on the cart paths using the 90-degree rule at all times. "Cart Path Only" situations will be determined by the Course Superintendent or Greens Committee. Failure to abide to these restrictions may cause loss of cart privileges.
- 2. Children of cart owners may operate their parent's carts under these conditions:
- a. Must be at least 16 years of age, 14 years of age or older if both parents have signed the Club's Indemnification Agreement.
- b. The Golf Pro must also approve for children under 16.
- c. Pro must approve times when children may use carts. (Never on Saturdays, Sundays, or Holidays.)
- d. All riders must be seated, no standing while cart is in motion.
- 3. Carts to be used for golf only NO "JOY RIDING".
- 4. Failure to abide by these rules may result in loss of cart privileges on MACC grounds.

House Member Rules

- 1. Any person who has been duly accepted as a house member of the Mount Airy Country Club shall be qualified to exercise the rights of a house membership.
- 2. Having qualified as a house member and upon payment of all dues for house membership, such member shall be entitled to all privileges of house membership including full use of the clubhouse and swimming pool.
- 3. Members of the household of a house member including spouse and dependent children are entitled to all privileges of house membership, subject only to such other rules and regulations as shall govern the participation of dependent children during their use of the tennis courts and their being in and around the swimming pool and clubhouse.
- 4. Violation of any rule governing house members by a member's guest, as herein after defined, or any member of his household will be considered as a violation of such rule by the member.
- 5. Definition: A dependent child, for purposes of these rules, is defined as a natural or adopted child under twenty-five (25) years of age, living in the same household as the member. A married dependent is not entitled to parents' membership privileges. The Board of Directors retain the right to allow exceptions for special needs on a case by case basis.

GUESTS

- 1. A house member guest is defined as any person who is not a house member and who is accompanied by a house member.
- 2. A house member is entitled to allow his guest to use any part of the club facilities properly accessible to house members while accompanied by such member.
- 3. Each member is responsible for the behavior of his guest(s) while using any facility.
- 4. Guests living within a twenty-five mile radius of Mount Airy are deemed in-town guests. Those living outside this twenty-five mile radius are deemed out-of-townguests.

IV. CLUBHOUSE RULES:

- A. All club functions are limited to members and their out-of-town guests. Exceptions may be allowed for special events. These will be posted.
- B. The clubhouse and related facilities are available for use by members and their guests during normal operating hours designated by the House Committee.
- C. Any member may reserve the ballroom of the clubhouse for a private function by making a reservation request to the House Committee or Executive Chef at least thirty days in advance of the function.
- D. The member reserving the ballroom and dining room facilities will be responsible for placing and removing all decorations, posters, flowers, and any other materials which are not part of the normal ballroom or dining room décor.
- E. Any rule posted or otherwise designated by the House Committee shall be complied with just as if it were contained in this document.
- F. Anyone under twenty-one (21) years of age will not be served any alcoholic beverage.
- G. Alcoholic beverages are not to be carried from the bar/lounge area into the Pro Shop. Any complaint arising from service in the bar or dining room areas are to be directed to the House Committee. Similarly, any question regarding rules or use of services is to be directed to the House Committee.

Swimming Pool Rules

- 1. Swimming will be allowed only during supervised hours.
- 2. No running inside pool fence.
- 3. No ducking or horseplay in pool.
- 4. No glass or other fragile containers allowed inside pool fence.
- 5. Any child under 14 years of age must be accompanied by an adult (18+ years old)

- 6. Life Guard on duty has complete authority over use of the pool and all personal conduct in the pool area.
- 7. Pets are not allowed inside the pool fence.
- 8. Smoking is not allowed inside the pool fence.
- 9. The only persons allowed inside the fenced pool area are members, their properly qualified immediate family, out-of-town guests without restriction and in-town guest as follows:
- 10. A member may bring one in-town guests. All guests much be accompanied by a member, such member is responsible for registering their guest/s in the pro shop before entering the pool and pay the guest fees as required. Failure to register guests will result in a \$25 Service fee being charged and may lead to suspension from member privileges.
- 11. The pool may be engaged for a private party on any evening between 6:30 and 9:00pm during the pool season except Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays. At least seven days in advance, proper reservation must be made with the Pool Committee Chairman. At least one adult member must attend the party throughout, and at least one qualified Life Guard must be on duty during the entire party at the expense of the responsible member.

Delinquencies

- 1. Members having balances more than 30 days (end of month) overdue will be notified that they are delinquent and have an additional 20 days (end of month) to pay their overdue balances and their current dues.
- 2. Members not complying with Part 1 will then be more than 60 days delinquent in paying their balance. At that point they will be suspended from all club activities. If members have balances more than 60 days overdue and do not plan to pay the entire balance within 30 days, they <u>must</u> seek out and talk with the club Treasurer and agree in writing to a payment plan that pays current dues, minimums, etc. and also retires the overdue debt. An active credit card will then be required to be on file.
- 3. Members who are habitually late in paying dues will be reviewed by the Board of Directors and at the discretion of the Board may lose membership privileges permanently.
- 4. If members allow their balances to go unpaid and no plan has been established to retire the debt for a period of greater than 90 days, will require Board of Directors approval to be reinstated. Further action from the club will include any legal remedies and/or collection agency efforts. Any debt incurred prior to this policy implementation are also subject to Section 3.
